Words of Welcome..... Yesterday afternoon we welcomed a gentleman into school who was visiting to carry out a curriculum assessment. Mrs Smith, who has responsibility for RE across the school, had applied to see if we had reached the Bronze standard for the Religious Education (RE) Quality Mark. Several of our children took the assessor around the school, showing him how RE learning happens across the curriculum. They talked about how the children are engaged and in charge of elements of their own RE learning. The children did really well and were praised by the assessor, so very well done to: **Declan Brookes, Joe Woolliscroft, Deanna Buckley, Andraya Knight, Jessica Booth, Chloe Stratford and Bethany Bridgwood**. The above children, along with **Lauren Dugdale, Evie-Mae Chetwynd and Macy Buckley** were also interviewed by the assessor. They were asked a number of questions, including: 'Even though RE is so good, how could it be made even better?' and 'What range of activities do you do in RE, such as art, drama, music?' This has been a fantastic effort by all the children, the staff and particularly Mrs Smith for pulling it all together. But did we achieve the Bronze award? NO – we were granted the Silver Award and will receive a Silver plaque and logo for our website! The first school in Stoke-on-Trent to be awarded it – very well done Mrs Smith!
