Thursday Maths Challenge

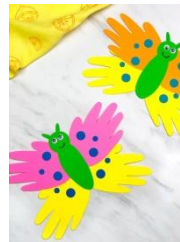
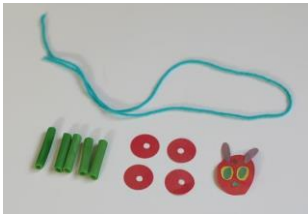
How many fruits did the caterpillar eat altogether?
