

Online camera safety

Many of us may be very aware of issues around older children being tricked into getting undressed or revealing themselves online. However, following recent surveys of younger children, law enforcement agencies such as NCA (National Crime Agency) and CEOP (Child Exploitation and Online Protection) have warned of sexual predators tricking young children into getting changed or undressed on camera by playing a 'game' or issuing a 'challenge' to see how fast they can get changed into different clothes or into a swimming costume. In response to this, around school we are putting up posters to remind the children to never get undressed

or change clothes when they are on camera. This is a further area of esafety which parents/carers might wish to talk with their children about. Further information is available at:
