#### **PEGI Ratings**

In the run up to Christmas, many of us may be thinking about buying games for consoles such as Xbox and PlayStation, for our children. **PEGI** age ratings are really helpful to provide guidance for parents to help us decide whether or not to buy a particular product.



PEGI 3 rating is suitable for all

**PEGI 7** rating contains scenes or sounds which might possibly frighten younger children

**PEGI 12** rating contains slightly more graphic violence and may possibly contain some mild bad language

**PEGI 16** ratings may show violence (or sexual activity) which looks the same as would be expected in real life. May also contain more extreme bad language and games of chance, and the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs can also be present.
