

These first two new classrooms should hopefully be completed ready for a move in the Easter holidays, but as with all things build-wise, the schedule is always open to change.

Before then, there will be the need for further trench digging across the main path, at the top of the slope down to the car park. This is for the laying of pipes for water, electrics,

data cables, etc from the main school to the new classrooms. We will of course do every thing we can to avoid disrupting access to the pathways, ensuring that all children and adults are safe and we will provide more information once details have been confirmed.
