Survey Says! The week before half term we were really pleased to welcome so many parents/carers into school for our

Open Evenings. Each year during these evenings we send out a survey via ParentMail about an aspect of school life. This year we asked your views on the transition process of your child moving years groups. Thank you to those 214 of you that responded. Below is a summary of the results:

- 1. I was given the information I needed about my child's new class routines, learning and expectations - 94% Agreed or Strongly Agreed; 4% Disagreed; 2% Didn't Know.
- 2. The parent/carer drop-in lessons are an important part of my child settling in their new class - 93% Agreed or Strongly Agreed; 3% Disagreed; 4% Didn't Know.
- 3. I would welcome parent/carer drop-in lessons: 44% Half termly; 43% Termly; 11% Yearly; 2% Not at all.

Many thanks to those of you that left comments. They have all been read and one resulting action is that next July we will send out letters detailing changes of routines, times, charges and procedures for the new class ready for the next academic year.
