
#### Monday

What is a pond? What creatures and plants are found there? This website introduces what a pond is and what we might see in or on a pond.

#### Tuesday

What is a frog and how do they grow? Explain to the children that a frog is not born as a frog, but comes from an egg which is called frogspawn. Explain the process – frogspawn, tadpole, froglet, frog and then the lifecycle starts all over again as the frog lays eggs – frogspawn again.

The website below explains each stage of the lifecycle.


