Tuesday

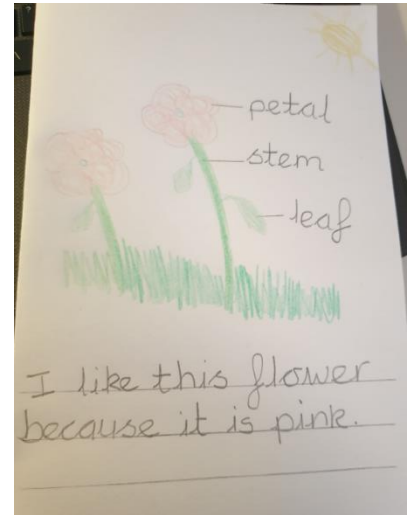
On your walk today or when playing in the garden, use the sheet at the end of the week's challenges to see how many of each type of plant you can see. Good luck hunting and spotting.

Maths challenge day.

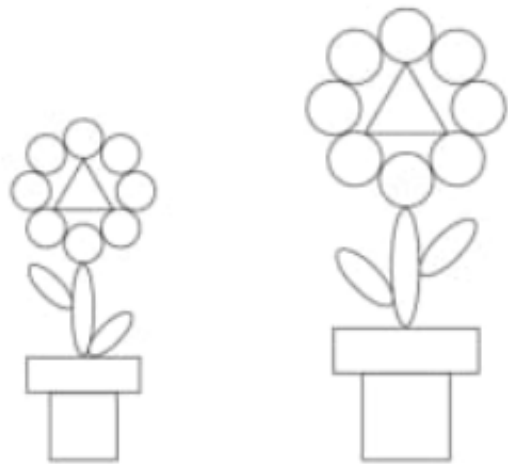
Can you use 2D shapes around your house to create a flower picture like this one.
