# **Arrangements for September**

#### **Attendance**

In March when the coronavirus outbreak was increasing, the Government made it clear that no parent would be penalised or fined for their child's non-attendance at school.

Now the circumstances have changed and it is vital for **all** children to return to school to minimise, as far as possible, the longer-term impact of the pandemic on our children's education, wellbeing and wider development.

Therefore, from September, **all** our attendance arrangements will revert back to how they were before the school closures.

We are currently finalising arrival and collections arrangements, such as one way systems, and will share these with you in next weeks newsletter.

## Communicating with the office

As parents will not be allowed into the school building, if you need to contact the school office or a member of staff for any reason, please either: email office@sandfordhill.org.uk; call 01782 235518 / 01782 235781 and leave a message on the answerphone or send any message via the absence field on the ParentMail app.

#### Milk

Milk for pupils in Y1-Y6 will be available to purchase for September, via ParentMail, from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July, at a cost of £16.25. This is for pupils that wish to have a carton of whole milk daily for the entire autumn term. It is completely optional, but orders for milk must be made by 9:00am on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020.

## **Dinner Money**

Due to the April increase in City Catering charges for school meals, our charge to parents for dinners will be increasing from £2.30 to £2.35 per day (£11.75 per week). Please be reminded that all dinner monies must be paid, via ParentMail, in advance and no later than 9:00am at the start of the week.

## **Medicines**

As children will be remaining in the class bubbles during the day, we will be unable to administer all but essential medicines to children. We will therefore only administer medication to those pupils who have a care plan, pupils with asthma (who cannot administer their own inhaler) and to pupils who have prescribed antibiotics that must be taken 4 times a day or more. All parents/carers should leave the medicine at front reception where parental permission will be recorded.

#### Leave of absence

If you need to take your child(ren) out of school during term time, you must complete a leave of absence form. Please contact the office who will then send you the form to complete via ParentMail.

### **Parent/Carer Contact Details**

It is vital that we have up to date contact information for all pupils in school. Please email the office if any of your contact or address details have changed since March, and also for any contacts linked to your child(ren).
