Welcome Back!

We do hope you managed to have a pleasant and safe half term break. Last Saturday at the end of the holiday, the second national lockdown, which began yesterday, was announced. On the BBC website there is a useful list of the 'Nine ways England's lockdown is different from last time':

- 1. You can meet one friend outside, socially distancing ... with your children;
- 2. Public toilets will not be closed;
- 3. Support 'Bubbles' exist';
- 4. Click and collect services will be available;
- 5. Sitting on a bench is allowed;
- 6. You can take unlimited exercise;
- 7. Dentist and opticians are staying open;
- 8. Nobody will formally shield; and most relevant
- 9. Schools and universities are staying open.

We were all delighted that one of the differences from last time is that schools are staying open. Being at school is vital for children's education and well-being. Indeed it is fabulous that our overall whole school attendance for this year is 96.4%. Despite this week having a number of staff self-isolating, it continues to be our aim, that all pupils in all year groups remain in school.

To help us with managing risk we would very much appreciate your continued support with the systems and procedures (below) that we have in place at the beginning and end of the school day.

- \Rightarrow Please continue to follow the 'One Way' system (even if the signs are no longer up);
- Please do wear a mask while on the school site. (Should this not be possible for you, for \Rightarrow whatever reason, then please contact the school office and we will try to arrange for your child to be collected/taken to the school gate where possible);
- Please keep paths clear at all times so that there is no congestion at busy cross over points; \Rightarrow
- Please 'Keep Off' the red ash car park. We cannot fence the whole path along the red ash, so \Rightarrow rely on parents to keep children safe on the path please.
- Scooters should be stored in the scooter pods by each entrance/exit and should not be ridden \Rightarrow on the school grounds.
- If any member of your household has COVID symptoms, please keep your children at home \Rightarrow until test results tell whether it is safe or they need to self-isolate;
- Please remember to use parent@sandfordhill.org.uk for any e-mail \Rightarrow communications to staff or use the ParentMail Absence option.
