### **Newsletter Survey Results**

Thank you to everybody that completed our newsletter survey. We had 388 responses which is 83% of our child numbers and the overwhelming feedback is really positive. Below is a summary of the findings and what actions we propose in response:

- 83% responded that they read the newsletter every week:
- 74% said to keep it weekly; 20% to go fortnightly and 7% monthly;
- Of those that said they only sometimes or never read the newsletter - 28% would prefer more through ParentMail notifications and 35% would prefer paper copies;
- Most of the items rated 62% or above as being useful, with Diary dates and notices highest.

#### What we are going to do as a result of your feedback:

- 1. The font size has been increased slightly to make for easier reading.
- 2. There will be a number of paper copies available for taking in front reception.
- 3. We will gradually be introducing the use of 'Events' on ParentMail so you will always have the correct dates to view in the ParentMail app.


