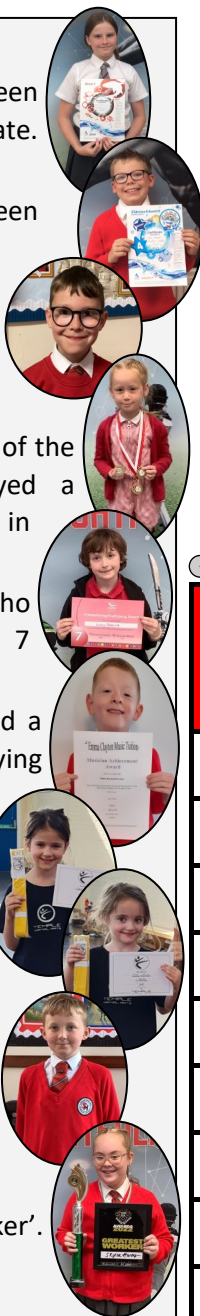
Please respect our neighbours
