At Sandford Hill, we encourage all of our pupils to attend school as much as possible. We understand that there are occasions when your child may be unwell but are you aware of what happens when your child is off for any reason?

As a school, we closely track children's attendance for both morning and afternoon sessions. Should your child not be in school, we are then required to allocate a code to account for their absence. If your child needs to attend a medical appointment during the school day, please only keep them out of school for their appointment time.

Even when you provide a reason for your child's absence, their attendance may still be affected. As soon as a child's attendance falls below 90%, they are defined, by the government, as a persistent absentee. This equates to your child having 1 day off per fortnight.

If a child has 90% absence across by the end of the academic year, it equates to almost 4 weeks of school or 120 guided learning hours - that is an awful lot of learning missed and an almost impossible gap to make up. To enable your child to reach their full potential, they need to be in school as much as possible.

Thank you for supporting school in ensuring that your child has the highest attendance possible.

The orange letters stay within the middle lines.


The green letters touch the bottom line.
