#### ParentMail Issues

#### School Assemblies

Last week, we spoke to the children in the assemblies about Louis Braille and Stevie Wonder, highlighting the importance of **equality.** We spoke about the challenges that people might face and adaptations that some people may require in their everyday life.

In our KS1 assemblies this week, we spoke to the children about the importance of a good nights sleep and the benefits of this. How much sleep you need can vary depending upon age and the NHS recommends that whilst babies will sleep for around 17 hours per day, older children may need 9-10 hours each night.
