Phonics at Sandford Hill

- •Our younger children are taught phonics every day at school.
- •Phonics breaks words down into individual sounds and this helps children to learn to read, write and spell.
- Information regarding which sounds have been taught are shared each week on our newsletter.
- •Each sound that the children are taught is accompanied by an action which helps the children to remember the sound. Videos showing the actions can be found on our school website: <u>https://sandfordhill.org.uk/our-school/</u> <u>phonics/</u>
- •When the children can read the first 12 sounds, they are given a reading book.
- •Reading books in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, match the children's phonic ability. The children read their books at school with the adults in the classroom.
- •Re-reading the same book several times, at school and at home, will help your child to become a much better reader!
