Year 4 Visit to The River Dane

On Wednesday and Thursday, the Year 4 classes travelled to the Peak District to learn about the features of a river. The children began their day at Axe Edge



Moor, near Buxton. Here, they saw the source of the River Dane. The children then progressed downstream towards Three Shire Head. Here the children studied the rocks and the landscape. After a lunch break at Tittesworth Reservoir, the children ended their day in Gradbach. Whilst here they measured the depth and speed of the water. The children learned lots of new vocabulary that will now help them with their Water Cycle geography topic next half term.


